Staff help promote the program, walk people through the application, and ensure they know how to use and maintain their benefits.





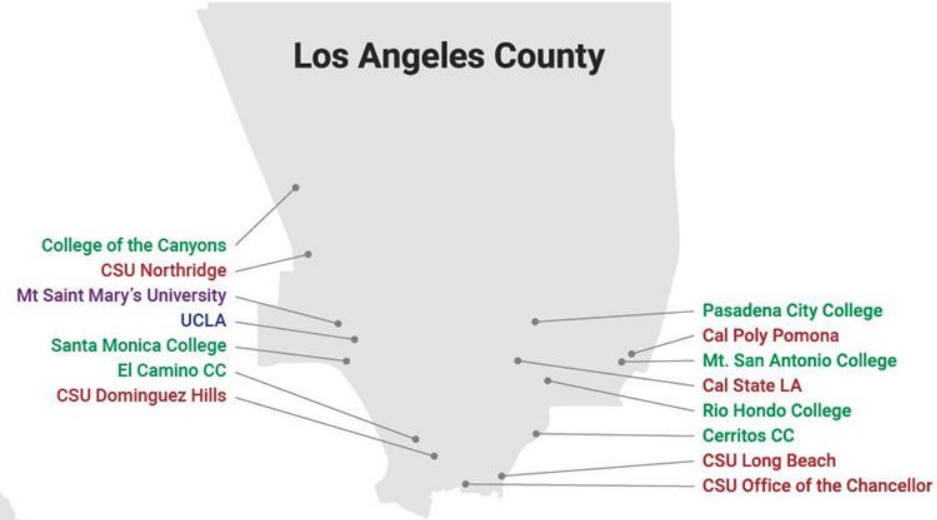
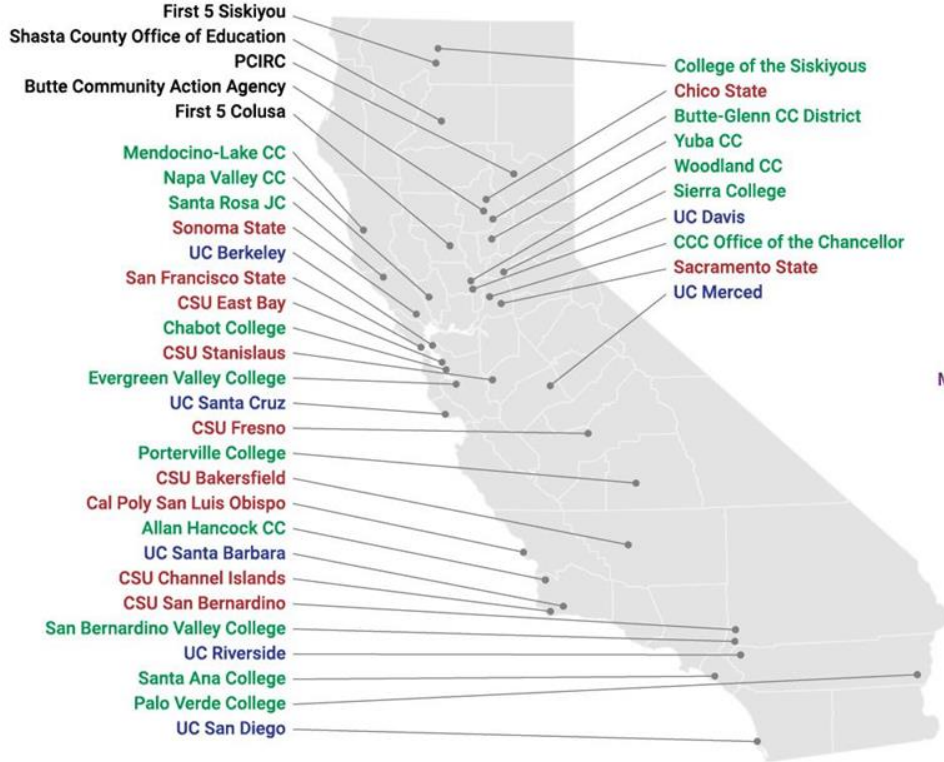
Subcontractors


